## HEARTWORM FOUND IN DOGS IN BENALLA, MANSFIELD, BEECHWORTH AND DEDERANG


You may be asking yourself 'do I really need to be concerned about Heartworm'?

- Yes, you really do.
- Infection with heartworm is fatal causing heart failure symptoms in your dog
- It is spread by **mosquitoes** and we've now had **confirmed cases** of dogs with heartworm in **Benalla**, **Mansfield**, **Beechworth** and **Dederang**. It's no longer something only to be worried about if you travel with your dog.
- Treatment involves lengthy stays in hospital, large expenses and your dog may not survive

It is recommended that all dogs in Australia be on heartworm prevention all year round

## So, how well protected is your dog?

 There are many monthly tablets and spot-ons out there, but unfortunately 40% of dogs that tested positive in the Heartworm Surveillance Project were on some type of monthly prevention. It's easy to forget a monthly dose, or even just be a little late – and a mosquito doesn't need long to bite.



The best way to keep your dog protected is a once a year injection - it's quick, easy and you don't need to worry about remembering monthly doses!

• **Dogs under 7 months** can go straight onto it and **dogs older than 7 months** just need a blood test to make sure they aren't already infected with heartworm (this test is repeated in 6 months).

In **November & December** we can do this first blood test for you **at no charge** when you then go on to the yearly injection. (**That'll save you \$85!**)
